

Exhibitor Information

Aim of the event:

At the Smart Farming Days, visitors will be shown real Smart Farming products around the agrirouter in the **Smart Farming Today** section. The **Smart Farming Tomorrow** section will focus on smart farming technologies of the future.

Visitors can find out about Smart Farming topics and their challenges in product-neutral expert forums (3 per day). In addition to the specialist forums, live demonstrations (3 per day) will take place on the 3 days of the event, during which the real data exchange between machines and/or various smart farming technologies (e.g. software and hardware products) can be experienced live. Rustic face-to-face networking evenings round off the event.

There will be 50 exhibitor stands for software and hardware partners as well as machinery manufacturers in the "**Smart Farming Today**" section (see site map PDF).

The agricultural machinery manufacturers of DKE-Data can display tractor-implement combinations, exhibits or self-propelled vehicles on the square in front of the machinery hall (see site map PDF) to present their use cases to visitors in the stand and/or during the live demos.

In addition to exhibiting agrirouter ready products, all exhibitors are also allowed to exhibit other smart farming products from their company.

Specialist forums in the barn:

- The event website lists 3 specialist forums per event day, which will be moderated by Guido Höhner (Editor-in-Chief of TopAgrar). These will be recorded to use afterwards on Youtube and Spotify. The expert forums will be product-neutral. If you would like to contribute to the panel discussions, please contact Jens Möller (j.moeller@dke-data.com). The final topics of the expert forums will be announced on the event website shortly before the event.
- In the background of the panelists, the current **All for One for All** logo wall (4.5m wide / 2m high) will be placed on the stage in the seated barn.
- Media technology is available in the barn and on the live demo stage. This will be supported at the event by the company L&S.



- The expert forums will be simultaneously translated into English. Non-German speaking visitors can follow the simultaneous translation with headphones.

Live demos:

There will be 3 live demonstrations daily on and in front of a stage in combination with an LED wall. The live demos will be recorded with a mobile camera for use afterwards on YouTube. The final topics of the live demos will be announced on the event website shortly before the event.

Benches for visitors will be placed in front of the stage for the live demonstrations (in the right-hand corner of the machinery hall in case of bad weather). A camera is mounted in the cabins of the machines involved, the image of which is displayed on the LED screen (Picture in Picture) next to the content of the laptop of the agricultural software provider involved. Additional media material such as PowerPoint slides or short film sequences can be brought by the exhibitors for the live demonstrations. This material must be handed over to the colleagues from L&S at the stage technology in the morning of the day of the exercise (13.06.23).

The live demos will be simultaneously translated into English. Non-German speaking visitors can follow the simultaneous translation with headphones.

Photos during the event:

A professional photographer will take photos all day during the event on the 1st day of the event, 14.06.23, which will be made available online to all exhibitors in raw format after the event.

Internet:

A local WLAN network with internet connection (via 2 StarLink receivers) will be available. Access data will be provided on the set-up day, 13.06.23.

Assembly/disassembly:

Set-up of the software and hardware as well as machine exhibitor stands can take place on 13.06.23 from 8 am - 7 pm. Each exhibitor can also test their technologies on this day. A test/trail of the live demos will take place in the afternoon of 13.06.23. Details on the day on site. A meal will be served for all exhibitors that evening.

Dismantling is possible on Friday, 16.06.23 from 6:30pm to 9pm or on Saturday, 17.06.23 from 8 am to 6 pm (see summary schedule below).

Furniture / Equipment Exhibitors Stands:

Each of the 50 software or hardware and machine manufacturer exhibitor stands are equipped with a counter with a table extension and 2 bar stools (see site map PDF).

Each counter contains a 27" monitor, aspect ratio 16:9, Ultra HD with HDMI cable, a USB mouse and a USB keyboard including USB hub.

A 220 V power supply is available at all exhibitor stands.

Logo placement on the counters:

All exhibitors must supply their logo in colour (company or product logo) for the counter panels (white background). The companies may determine themselves which logo (product or company) is to be displayed on the counter panels. Full-surface logos for the counter panels are not intended.

Catering:

Registration / Login process:

All visitors to Smart Farming Days 23 (**guests, press, exhibitors, internal employes**) must register for the event online in advance via <https://smartfarmingdays.com/>.

Lanyards with name tags will be available at the entrance tent for all registered visitors and exhibitors on their first visit to the event.

Visitors who have not registered in advance of the event can register at the entrance tent on the days of the event. The name badge will then be printed out on site.

A maximum of 500 visitors can be received per event day.



Placement of exhibitors:

Approximately 2-3 weeks before the event, DKE-Data will invite all registered exhibitors to a team meeting to announce the placement of the exhibitors' stands and the positioning of the machines / machine combinations and equipment.
